

# HOUSEHOLD POLLUTION





33 tons of household waste are made by the average person in his lifetime.



Each person in Slovenia makes 436 kg of waste a year.



36% of all waste in Slovenia is separated before throwing away.

# OUR TRASH IMPACTS THE ENVIRONMENT

## HOW CAN WE HELP

Reusing as much as possible, not buying too much things, take care of water and food.

With recycling of 1 ton of paper we save 20% of trees and 40 liters of clean water.

The recycling of one glass bottle, can save up energy for a computer to work for 30 min.



# RECYCLING IN SLOVENIA

Slovenia has 12.109 ecological islands - glass, paper, organic trash, plastic.

In Ljubljana the trash bins are underground and locked with a **key card**.

62,4 % of **paper** in Slovenia is recycled.





We use recycled toilet paper in Ljubljana in public toilets.



We use plates and straws from recycled paper.

More and more houses in Slovenia use underground reservoirs for collecting rainwater. Families use them for flushing toilets, for washing machines, watering gardens.
